Behavioral Health

Kinship of Park Rapids is dedicated to fostering positive youth development by providing caring and supportive mentors to youth facing challenges or at risk of falling behind. The program is designed to strengthen youth's sense of belonging, resilience, and self-efficacy, enabling them to navigate life's transitions and make informed decisions that lead to successful futures. Kinship facilitated 22 mentor/mentee matches and recruited over 60 Reading Buddies in Park Rapids and Nevis Schools.

Health Related Social Needs

Provided 93 car seats to families enrolled in PrimeWest or Medical Assistance.

Obesity

The Medical Weight Management program supported 142 participants in making positive lifestyle changes and reducing risk factors for chronic disease. These participants were enrolled in the MOVE exercise program.
