Social Determinants of Health

The Women, Infant and Children (WIC) program offered through Community Health, provides nutrition assessment, education and food benefits to eligible individuals. Eligibility includes pregnant, breastfeeding, and postpartum persons, as well as infants (0-1 years) and children (1-5 years). The hospitals WIC program maintained an average monthly participation rate of 505, consistent with caseload averaging over 500 since 2022.

Health Related Social Needs

Provided 93 car seats to families enrolled in PrimeWest or Medical Assistance.

Community Health

Provided education on special needs of bariatric patients, including nutrition and diet, psychosocial needs and lifestyle choices to 70 community members.
